<u>English Task 1</u> Log on to Mirodo and complete the questions linked to adjectives.	<u>English Task 2</u> Log on to Mirodo and complete the questions linked to punctuation at the end of a sentence.	<u>English Task 3</u> Log on to Mirodo and complete the questions linked to prepositions.
<u>Maths Task 1</u> Log on to Mirodo and complete the questions linked to place value.	<u>Maths Task 2</u> Log on to Mirodo and complete the questions linked to ordering and comparing numbers.	<u>Maths Task 3</u> Log on to Mirodo and complete the questions linked to mental addition and subtraction.
<u>Curriculum Task 1</u> In Geography, you have been learning about Earthquakes. Create a leaflet or poster telling people how to keep safe in an earthquake.	<u>Curriculum Task 2</u> In Science you have been learning about light. Go on a hunt around your house for objects which give off light.
