



World Book Day 2020



On World Book Day, **Thursday 5th March**, children are invited to come to school dressed as their favourite book character. They can also bring along the book they are going to share with their class. During this day, children will take part in book and poetry themed activities as well as having the opportunity to visit different adults around the school to listen to them share their favourite stories.

This year, we will also be taking part in the nationwide Share a Million Stories campaign, which aims to spread the love of reading. From the 27th February to the 29th March every time your child shares a story for 10 minutes or more they can record it on their class log, which could win book prizes for our school. (Look out for further information and the logs in their reading records after half-term.)

HOMework TASKS

Children are invited to write an original story up to a maximum of 500 words, due in by **Friday 28th February**. If you wish, you can also officially submit the story to the Radio 2 competition to win book prizes for yourself and the school. Online deadline Thursday 27th February.

We will also be running a World Book Day Bake Off competition where children can make and decorate book themed cakes. All entries to come into school on **Thursday 5th March**. These will be then sold at breaktime, after they have been judged.



On World Book Day you will also be given a £1 Book Voucher which you can exchange at a book shop for one of the books which have been especially written for this year's Book Day or use towards the cost of another book.
