Clarity around those rewards were asked for.</p> <p>Some parents that were new to year 3 and our school were concerned about the difference in the communication between the infant schools and the junior school. A possible meeting in September was mooted to explain more about what systems the school uses.</p> <p>It was raised that some of the parents would like the teacher’s photos on the website. Mr Mortimer explained that the photos are up in reception, however, for consent reasons, we would need to consult with staff for their photos to be on the school website.</p> <p>It was raised that communication with the parents at the same time as the children would be beneficial i.e. sending home a short parent mail if there are changes.</p> <p><i>Positive Feedback</i></p> <p>The children are really enjoying the daily mile and the fact that the teachers and headteacher is also doing this shows the emphasis the school is placing on exercise.</p> <p>The majority of children have transitioned well.</p> <p>Parents are generally happy with the school.</p> <p>The Parent’s Forum is a good idea to take constructive feedback moving forwards.</p> | <p>Mr Mortimer to look into whether we can send the reading comprehension answers home for parents to use in a similar manner to checking the Maths homework answers.</p> <p>Mr Mortimer to look into clarity for rewards for homework.</p> <p>Mr Mortimer to discuss workshops for parents across the year with staff.</p> <p>Look to run a Year 3 parents meeting in September to explain the systems that are used in more detail.</p> |
