Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS)

Last week the school took part in a national competition organized by TTRS which saw 3887 schools vying to be crowned the best at times tables in the country. Emerson Valley finished in 348th place with the average score being 1862 answers correct per pupil, the overall score for the school was a fantastic 523,198 correct answers, the 74th highest score nationally.

Amongst the schools taking part there were 31,039 individual classes. The top performing class at Emerson Valley was 4BM with many of them playing at home in the evenings and on Saturday. Their average score was 8868 correct answers per pupil which saw them finish in 104th place nationally. More impressive was their total score which saw them amass a truly amazing 266,033 correct answers meaning they were the 41st placed class nationally. Well done!

Non- Uniform Day- Friday 27th November


Next Friday we will be holding a non-uniform day (minimum £1 donation applies) to help raise funds towards Children in Need and our sponsored Koala Bear.
